



Revenue Breakdown by Product Portfolio and Hazardous Substance Classification - 2025

Petkim tracks the percentage of revenue generated from products classified as hazardous by applicable regulatory authorities. In 2025, approximately 54% of Petkim's total revenue was generated from products classified as hazardous. Petkim conducts product risk assessments covering its entire product portfolio to evaluate potential impacts on human health and the environment. Accordingly, 100% of products (in terms of revenue) are assessed through Petkim's product stewardship and regulatory compliance processes to ensure compliance with applicable chemical safety and environmental regulations.
